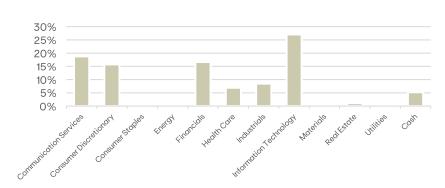

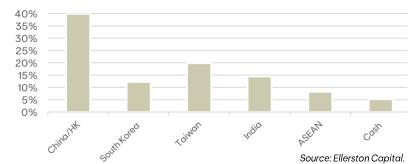

PORTFOLIO COMMENTARY

The Ellerston Asia Growth Fund Complex ETF (EAFZ) delivered +4.2% (net) for the month, underperforming the MSCI Asia ex Japan (non-accumulation) Index (AUD) (Benchmark), which delivered +5.2%. For the quarter the fund returned +9.2% relative to the Benchmark which returned +9.0%.

China's economic momentum slowed in the September quarter, compared to the strong first half of the year, with authorities announcing further targeted stimulatory measures to ensure they meet their 5% GDP target. Focus will be on China's fourth Plenum to discuss the next 5-year plan in late October. The US and China tariffs truce continues to 10 November and recent US/China deals, such as the "framework" that would result in TikTok being US-owned and allowed to continue operating in the country, are likely to extend the duration of the truce. The current status quo has been positive for Asian equity markets. The Hang Seng rallied (+7.6%), followed by Korea's KOSPI (+7.5%), Japan's Nikkei (+5.9%), China's SSE (+1.9%), with India's SENSEX being the laggard at +0.6%. For the month, India was the largest contributor to alpha, while China was the relative underperformer. The Fund's underperformance was primarily due to its lower beta exposure in a broad-based "everything rally" environment. Earlier in the month, we adopted a relatively cautious stance on Al stocks—reducing our overweight positions in popular names—and increased exposure to some of our beaten-down quality stocks. However, the Oracle-OpenAl partnership reignited market enthusiasm for the Al theme, making our rotation appear somewhat early in hindsight. That said, as fundamental investors, our decisions were valuation-driven rather than market-timing calls, and we believe these positioning changes will contribute positively to alpha in the coming months.

KEY MONTHY CONTRIBUTOR

TSMC (2330 TT) performed strongly in September as robust Al-driven semiconductor demand boosted investor confidence. The company reported a 31% year-on-year revenue increase, underscoring sustained strength in advanced chip sales for Al and data centres. Optimism around TSMC's leadership in 3 nm production, improving margins, and resilient pricing power lifted sentiment, while analysts raised earnings forecasts ahead of Q3 results, driving the stock higher through the month.

KEY MONTHLY DETRACTOR

Alibaba (9988 HK)'s share price posted strong gains in September, driven by investor enthusiasm around its Al and cloud momentum. The company's latest results showed cloud revenue up \sim 26% year-on-year and Al-related product income growing triple digits, offsetting softer performance in its core e-commerce business. Analysts responded by raising earnings estimates and price targets, further fuelling buying interest. Meanwhile, Alibaba's plan to issue a large convertible bond to fund cloud expansion—and its growing partnerships (e.g., with NVIDIA)—signalled strong conviction in its long-term strategy. While we remain constructive on Alibaba's cloud business, the Fund maintained an underweight position due to ongoing competition concerns in the e-commerce segment. This underweight was funded by our holdings in GDS (9698 HK), which rose over 18% during the month. As Alibaba Cloud's primary data centre provider, GDS offers exposure to Alibaba's cloud growth without taking on the e-commerce—related risks.

OUTLOOK

We believe Asia is extremely well positioned to outperform in the current environment, supported by a weaker U.S. dollar, recalibrated expectations around ongoing tariff negotiations and light global investor positioning. That said, as an active fund manager, we remain mindful of risks related to geopolitical tensions, potential over-exuberance in AI themes, and, importantly, how investors in different markets perceive these risks. The resulting divergence in market expectations continues to make it challenging to hold high-conviction country or sector allocations. As such, we maintain our focus on bottom-up stock selection while keeping overall beta exposure contained to mitigate macro risks.
